HEARING LOSS SERVICES**

SIGNS OF HEARING LOSS MAY INCLUDE:

- Trouble hearing over the phone or on video calls
- Difficulty understanding others when 2 or more people are talking at the same time
- Need to turn up TV so loud that others complain
- Having a problem hearing because of background noise
- Sensing that others seem to mumble
- Constantly asking for others to repeat themselves
- Straining to understand conversation
- Missing essential sounds like doorbells, alarm clocks or smoke alarms
