

CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) Testing Sites

Who Should Get Tested?

Not everyone needs to be tested. If you do get tested, self-quarantine/isolate at home pending test results and follow the advice of your health care provider or a public health professional. **If you do not have a doctor, need help getting one, or need help accessing a test you can call the TMH Transition Center at 850-431-4470.** Considerations for testing:

- Anyone who has symptoms of COVID-19, **regardless of vaccination status**
- Most people who have been within **6 feet** for a total of **15 min.** with someone with confirmed COVID-19
- **Unvaccinated** people who have taken part in activities that put them at higher risk for COVID-19 because they cannot socially distance, such as travel, large social gatherings, or being in crowded indoor settings
- Anyone who has been asked or referred to get tested by their healthcare provider or health department

COVID-19 Testing Sites

Many **Primary Care Providers** offer testing in their offices and should be the first option you consider. Also, **'Pop-Up' mobile testing sites** can be found at varying locations each week. For more information visit cms.leoncountyfl.gov/covid-19/Vax-Map and click [Find a Site Near You](#). **No cost PCR testing is available for Leon County Schools' students and employees at the following locations 9 a.m. – 2 p.m., Monday – Friday: Eastside Branch Library, Ft. Braden Community Park, Lake Jackson Public Library, Northeast Branch Library, and the Woodville Community Center. These are drive-thru sites, no appointment is needed, and results are available within 24 hours. Additionally, appointments can be made for testing at Jack McLean Community Center, Lawrence-Gregory Community Center, Sue H. McCollum Community Center, and Walker-Ford Community Center; visit leonschools.net/ for details.**

Free testing is available at the **FAMU-Bond Testing Site at Bragg Stadium (1500 Wahnish Way)**. The site is open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Mon – Sat; visit testing.nomihealth.com/easy_registration/113/onsite to make an appointment.

Old West Enrichment Center (2344 Lake Bradford Rd). Testing is free and available 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday. Visit curative.com to schedule an appointment, and for questions about test results email curativesupport@curative.com or call **888-702-9042**.

Free PCR testing available from the Health Department seven days a week from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. at two locations: **2965 Municipal Way & 3840 N. Monroe St.**, to make an appointment visit testing.nomihealth.com/signup/fl.

Ten CVS Pharmacy locations are offering testing (**symptomatic patients only**). Testing is free to the uninsured, but patients must register in advance at [CVS.com](https://www.cvs.com).

Walgreens Pharmacy (2349 Monroe St. & 2913 Mahan Dr.) is offering testing (**symptomatic patients only**). An insurance and ID card if required and patients must register in advance at [walgreens.com](https://www.walgreens.com).

Patients First: Drive-Thru (535 Appleyard Dr.) testing available Mon – Fri, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Appointments required, and can be scheduled [here](#) or by calling **850-877-7164**. **Curb Side (3446 Thomasville Rd)** open daily from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m., schedule appointment [here](#) or call **850-386-2266**. A fee of \$175 may apply.

The CDR Health Testing Center (1981 Capital Circle NE) is providing testing Mon - Sun from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Appointments at CDR-Health.com preferred but not required. Insurance is not accepted, and testing fees start at \$135. Call **850-738-7977** or email info@cdr-health.com for more information.

Wellness Medical Clinic (1931 Welby Way) insurance not accepted, and the cost is \$100 for COVID-19 PCR test, \$125 for Rapid Antigen test. Call **850-545-9376** to make an appointment.

Pixel by LabCorp COVID-19 (At-Home Test Kit) is now available to the public, more information can be found at pixel.labcorp.com/at-home-test-kits/covid-19-test-home-collection-kit.

Most health insurance providers are covering the cost of testing, including [Medicare](#), [CHP](#) and [Blue Cross Blue Shield of Florida](#). If you don't have insurance, contact that TMH Transition Center at **850-431-4470** for assistance getting a test.
