2 Pencil
Sharpener
Tracing Paper
Transfer Paper
Kneaded Eraser
Watercolor Paint Tubes or Pans

Best Tube Watercolor Brands – Grumbacher, Winsor Newton and/or Liquitex

START WITH MAIN COLORS

Yellow
Yellow Ochre
Alizarin Crimson
Hookers Green
Ultra-Marine Blue
Burnt Umber

ADD LATER

Cerulean Blue
Cobalt Blue
Cadmium Orange
Sap Green
Burnt Siena

Watercolor Paper

Watercolor Paper sealed edge pads are the easiest to work with for beginners (Not Required)

Strathmore and Cottman 140lb cold press are ok – Arches is more expensive but the BEST

Watercolor Paper comes in different weights and surfaces including watercolor board, cold-pressed, rough paper, hot-pressed paper and handmade papers.

Brushes

At least one flat ¾ to 1 inch, couple of size 10 to 12 round brushes and one small round. Add fan brush when you can.

Note: Acrylic brushes may be a better choice. The water color brushes at Michael's shed!

Other

Paint well or pan, Jar for water, Toothbrush, Viva paper towels, Salt
