SYLLABUS

Colored Pencil For Beginners

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Course Description

Students will be introduced to principles and techniques of basic colored pencil drawing using dry media with an emphasis on its formal language and working from photographs and direct observation. Students will become familiar with the tools of colored pencil drawing and the proper use of the medium. Students will gain knowledge on how to purchase proper tools for continued colored pencil arts endeavors. Students will learn about pencil types, pencil accessories, pencil point and holding techniques, color theory, and color mixing. Students will learn through class, the fundamentals of colored pencil drawing technique. The first section of three classes will be revolved around this formal training as well as preparing a final project. The last three classes will be the completion of the final project. During one class students (as a group), may choose an artist of their choice, to have a one hour art history presentation. Students may choose to utilize their own time to complete their final project.

Course goals and Objectives:

Gain knowledge of drawing tools, materials and techniques.

Understand pencil types, pencil accessories, pencil holding techniques, pencil point techniques.

Learn and understand Color Theory and Color Wheels how to mix colored pencil.

Learn how to blend colored pencil, Learn how to create textures with colored pencil.

Learn to work in a communal studio environment.

Develop the ability to evaluate one's own work and the work of others.

Course Requirements:

Come to class prepared with supplies.

Attend all classes and be present and work during class

Participate in class discussions

Purchase required course materials and tools

Complete final project to the best of your ability (come with a project in mind).

All fixative use is to be done outdoors away from others.
